Vehicle Crash and Fire at 13400 South, 5200 West

A vehicle crash late Saturday night caused an explosion and structure fire at 5200 W 13400 S. An evacuation order was issued and lifted in the early-morning hours of Sunday after the resulting natural-gas leak was contained.

All westbound lane closures on 13400 S were removed at 9:30 a.m.; the roadway is fully open.

The fire-damaged property is fenced and off-limits, and the adjacent sidewalk is closed. Pedestrians should use an alternate route through the area.

The long-term status of the multi-tenant commercial building is still being evaluated. Herriman City's water pump facility, attached to the structure, has been inspected; the equipment is undamaged and the water supply is safe.

Vehicle owners may retrieve cars left at the site after notifying Herriman Police at 801-840-4000.

The Riverton Police Department is leading the investigation. Witnesses or anyone with information are asked to contact Riverton PD by calling dispatch (801-840-4000; case number #RV25-11563).
